After *The Seven Crystal Balls* set the eerie stage, Tintin and his friends continue their adventures in Peru. There Tintin rescues an orange-seller named Zorrino from being bullied, and the young man becomes their guide in their quest to find the Temple of the Sun. But they find more than they bargained for and end up in a hot spot. The perils of this engaging two-part adventure are especially harrowing in their combination of the supernatural and the real, although the resolution is a little too *deus ex machina*. Calculus and the Thompsons provide their usual comic relief. --David HoriuchiHergé, one of the most famous Belgians in the world, was a comics writer and artist. The internationally successful *Adventures of Tintin* are his most well-known and beloved works. They have been translated into 38 different languages and have inspired such legends as Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein. He wrote and illustrated for *The Adventures of Tintin* until his death in 1983.
