Even though Bonhoeffer studied abroad and worked for a time in Rome, and the United States, he was always cognizant of the struggles that Germans, especially those of Jewish descent, were enduring under Hitler's regime. Chapters in the audiobook are matched with the years chronicled in Bonhoeffer's journals, and writings, so listeners can easily follow the time line of events and correlate them to the events in Germany under Hitler's regime.
