## **Abstract**

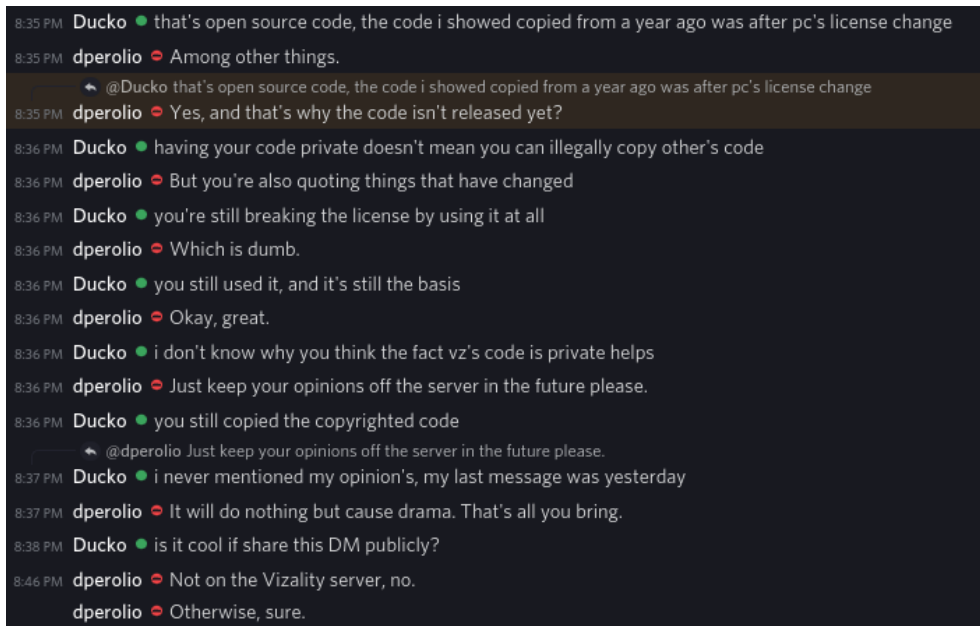
After publishing the initial findings report, the proceeding actions from Vizality's creator, dperolio, shows that the code shown to be copied from the initial report was intentionally and knowingly copied from Powercord, even though the code was from after it's license change (which forbids such copying). This small additional report is only on copied code, nothing else.

## **Initial Findings**

As described in our initial findings report published in Late June / Early July[1], we found various clear examples of Vizality copying code from Powercord - after it's license change to make such copying disallowed. That evidence will not be repeated here as to not copy and waste our and reader's time. To see such evidence look at the initial findings, linked in the references at the end of the document.

## **Post-release**

After the release of the initial findings report, it showed a surprising impact we did not expect (or hoped for). However, one good outcome from it's publish was a short interview with Vizality's creator, dperolio. From this interview / discussion, we have come to the conclusion that the code was intentionally, and knowingly copied from Powercord. The creator believes this is okay due to Vizality being closed source, even though the license still forbids it.
